Persons so appointed shall be eligible for consideration for the regular appointment to the position of Assistant Professor upon fulfilment of requisite work experience.</p> <p>Candidates not having Ph.D. but having a post graduate degree in appropriate discipline, with first class or equivalent and a very good and consistent academic record throughout and having three years of teaching/research/industrial experience, may be considered for appointment on contract against the position of Assistant Professor.
