#### C. Age

Age as on **31 Jan 2017 shall** not exceed 35 years, relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST candidates, 15 years for PWD (SC/ST) candidates, 13 years for PWD (OBC) candidates and 10 years for PWD (unreserved) candidates. Age relaxation of five years applicable for candidates who have been domicile of Jammu & Kashmir during the period 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989. Maximum age limit after applying relaxation in age will be 50 years.

### D. Method of Selection

(i) For all posts, depending upon the number of candidates eligible/ short-listed, the selection process will be held at Cochin Shipyard Limited, Kochi or at any other place in Kochi/Kerala on dates notified by Shipyard. Request for change in venue/dates of tests will not be entertained. The method of selection for all posts will include <a href="Phase I">Phase I</a>, consisting of an Objective type written test and <a href="Phase I">Phase II</a> consisting of Descriptive / Skill / Practical Test.

- (ii) For all posts, based on the marks secured in the Phase I written test, the candidates will be short-listed according to the cut-off marks and / or in the ratio of 1:7 for attending Phase II. Syllabus for Phase II selection is same as that of Phase I. Further details of Phase II selection will be communicated to the short-listed candidates separately.
- (iii) A final merit list for the respective posts shall be prepared based on the marks secured by the candidates in both Phase I and Phase II tests put together. **Only candidates who secure a minimum of 33.33% in the aggregate, will be ranked and considered for selection in the order of merit/ reservation as applicable.**

#### E. Syllabus

(i) In **Phase I**, the question paper for Objective type written test consists of two parts-**General (Part A) and Trade/ Discipline related (Part B). Part A comprises of General Knowledge, General English, Reasoning and Quantitative Aptitude.** The pattern of the question paper, number of questions and allotment of marks is detailed under:

#### G. Conditions

#### i) Reservation:

- a) Government of India Directives on reservation applicable for Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC)/OBC (Minority)/Persons with Disabilities (PWD) / Ex-Servicemen (ESM) candidates will apply and be strictly followed.
- b) Candidates belonging to SC or ST or OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), should produce <u>a</u> <u>valid recent community certificate</u> issued by the Revenue Authority not below the rank of the Tahsildar, failing which their candidature will not be considered against the reserved posts.
- c) In the case of Persons with Disabilities, the degree of disability should be minimum of 40%. The candidate should possess *valid Certificate of Disability* to this effect in the prescribed format obtained from a notified authority by Government of India/State Government.
- **Physical requirements:** The physical requirement for the posts reserved for Persons with Disabilities include ST, S, W, BN, L, SE, KC, MF, H, RW and PP (ST-Standing, S-Sitting, W-Walking, BN-Bending, L-Lifting, SE-Seeing, KC-Kneeling & Crouching, MF-Manipulating with Fingers, H-Hearing, RW-Reading & Writing, PP-Pulling and Pushing).

#### iii) **Qualification**:

- a) Those candidates having qualifications equivalent to any of the prescribed qualifications should enclose <u>Equivalency Certificate</u> issued by the competent authority along with their application and **without such certificate**, **their candidature will not be considered**.
- b) For posts at Sl No. 1 to 3, relaxed standards in qualification requirement (55% of marks and above in qualifying examination) will be followed, provided they satisfy all other requirements.
- c) The educational qualifications must be regular/full time courses from a University/Institution. The courses should be recognized by the appropriate statutory authority/ State/ Central Government.
- d) Certain Universities/Institutes/Board of Technical Education do not award Class or Percentage of marks and allot Aggregate Grade Points (e.g. CGPA/OGPA/CPI etc). In case, the University/Institute/Board defines criteria for conversion of Aggregate Grade Point into Class and/or percentage of marks in the candidates' mark lists, the same will be accepted. However, where the University/ Institute/ Board does not define criteria for conversion of Aggregate Grade Point into Class and/or percentage of marks, the Aggregate Grade Points may be multiplied by 10 to get the required percentage of marks.

#### iv) Experience:

- a) Post qualification experience only will be considered. Period of experience will be reckoned as on 31 January 2017.
- b) The period of Apprenticeship Training in the relevant trade under the Apprentices Act 1961, will be treated as experience. Period of Advanced/ADS training in Cochin Shipyard will also be treated as experience for determining eligibility. Experience Certificates obtained from Shipyards/ Ports/ Dockyards/ Government Establishments /Heavy Engineering Companies/Private sector companies registered under the Companies Act or Foreign Shipyards/Companies of equivalent status will only be considered for short- listing and for consideration for selection. Any paid training will also be treated as experience.
- c) Work experience obtained from contractors (Proprietary Firms and Partnership Firms) engaged by Shipyards/Ports/ Dockyards / Government Establishments/Heavy Engineering Companies/Private sector companies may be considered based on the endorsement of the Principal Employer or Labour Enforcement Authorities, on the certificates issued by the contractor. Such candidates are required to produce further proof such as ESI/EPF statements to substantiate their claims. Certificates of training issued by contractors (Proprietary Firms and Partnership Firms) will not be considered.
- d) Ex-servicemen having NTC and NAC equivalent certificates should have working experience in the relevant trade in the Armed Forces. They should produce Discharge Certificate/ Book and all certificates indicating qualification and work experience in the relevant discipline in the Armed Forces. They should

produce experience certificate from the authorities concerned, **failing which their** candidature will not be considered.

- e) Experience requirement will be relaxed at the discretion of the Shipyard, if sufficient number of candidates in these categories are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
- Govt) should enclose either the **copy of experience certificate** or the **copy of appointment / offer of appointment issued by the company along with the copy of last drawn Pay Slip** as proof of experience, with the application format sent by post. For past employment, **experience certificate indicating the date of joining as well as date of relieving** should be produced. If selected, the candidates should produce all certificates in original to establish the experience claimed in their application format, failing which the offer letter issued to them will be treated as cancelled.
- g) In case of candidates who are working in Government Departments or Semi Government/Public Sector Organisations, their applications **should either be received at Cochin Shipyard Ltd through proper channel or they should submit "No Objection Certificate"** from the employer along with the application, or should produce "No Objection Certificate" from their employer at the time of certificate verification, failing which their candidature will be cancelled/rejected.

#### v) General:

- a) Applications received from candidates belonging to respective categories (ST/PWD) as per item A, will only be considered.
- b) Candidates are advised to make sure that they are meeting the eligibility requirements as per the notification for the posts, before submitting their applications.
- c) Depending upon number of applications received for all posts, **the candidates will be called for certificate verification either before or after Phase I selection**. Accordingly, Shipyard reserves the right to restrict number of candidates for Phase I selection.
- d) Candidates called for certificate verification should bring a photo identity proof (in original) like PAN Card, Aadhar, Driving Licence, Election ID card etc, original certificates towards proof of age, qualification, experience, caste, disability etc and self-attested copies of certificates and mark sheets, for verification, and their candidature will be considered on the strength of those certificates. In case of failure to produce the original certificates and marksheets, the candidates will not be allowed to attend the Phase I selection and their candidature will be rejected.
- e) If at any stage, it is found that any information furnished is false / incorrect or the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility requirements, the candidature is liable to be cancelled / rejected, without notice.

- f) No correspondence regarding the rejection of application in case of ineligibility will be entertained.
- g) ST/PWD candidates appearing for Phase I and Phase II shall be reimbursed single to & fro sleeper class rail fare, as applicable by the shortest route from the mailing address mentioned in their application form to Cochin Shipyard Ltd, Kochi on production of proof and as per rules. Candidates claiming travel re-imbursement are required to submit the copy of front page of bank passbook with account number and IFSC code, at the time of Phase I / Phase II selection and the eligible amount of reimbursement will be credited to their mentioned account through NEFT. Reimbursement of travel fare will only be made to those candidates who submit the above details. However, at the time of certificate verification, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, he/she will neither be allowed to attend the Phase I and Phase II nor be paid any Travelling Allowance.
- h) Shipyard reserves the right to conduct additional examination/skill test or call for any additional documentary evidence in support of educational qualification and experience of the candidates indicated in their application.
- i) Shipyard reserves the right to fix minimum pass mark for Written/Skill/Practical tests at its sole discretion.
- j) Submission of application and Issue of admit card for the selection shall not confer any right to the candidate of acceptance of candidature or cannot be construed as an acknowledgement of fulfilling the eligibility criterion.
- k) Applicants should be of sound health and satisfy the medical fitness standards as fixed by the company. The selected candidates should undergo a medical examination in the hospitals as prescribed by the company and medical fitness of selected candidates are further subject to verification by the Company Medical Officer.
- l) Appointment of selected candidates will be subject to verification of character and antecedents and verification of caste certificates if applicable.
- m) Cochin Shipyard reserves the right to change the number of vacancies, and to restrict/alter/cancel/modify the recruitment process, if need so arises without notice or assigning any reason thereof.
- n) Any legal proceedings in respect of any claim or dispute arising out of this advertisement and/or an application in response thereto can be instituted only in the Courts/Tribunals/Forums at Ernakulam and such Courts/ Authorities shall have sole and exclusive jurisdiction.
